Mr. Gillen represented BASF in SOCMA's Environmental Quality Committee, including 5 years as chairman and also served on the SOCMA Board of Governors for 4 years. Most recently, he was on a SOCMA workgroup to develop EHS&S metrics.

In support of BASF operations, Mr. Gillen has developed and led EHS compliance and systems audits and conducted training in policy, program and procedure development; ISO 14001, including aspect and impact identification; risk-based decision making; the impact of "green issues" on the chemical industry; performance metrics; and activity-based EHS cost accounting.

Mr. Gillen was Project Manager for the Gap Analysis of the BASF Corporation Elastocell® facility's RC14001 management system, which led to the first RC14001 certification issued. He has developed and conducted public training courses for ABS Government Institutes in EH&S Communication, ISO 14001, and Greening of the Government - Federal Facility Compliance with Executive Order 13148.

Mr. Gillen has presented at industry and government sponsored conferences on various EHS&S, Responsible Care and EMS topics such as ACC's Responsible Care Conferences, SOCMA's INFORMEX, Air & Waste Management Association (A&WMA), Joint Services P2 Conferences, and SOCMA Environmental Workshops.
