

**SIEF's, Consortia and Data Confidentiality**

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- SIEF – A group of entities with an agreement that one or more substances will be considered together for the purposes of a test plan.
  - SIEF – Substance Information Exchange Forum
  - Agreement on registration substance identity
    - Purity
    - By-products
    - Impurities
  - ECHA does not define structure or requirements
  - Must include sharing of all vertebrate test results
    - Existing
    - Newly performed
    - planned
  - Should include consideration of:
    - Use of QSAR's to avoid animal testing
    - Read across
    - Grouping to avoid animal testing
- Consortia – A group of entities with an agreement that one or more substances are to be registered together.
  - Agreement on registration substance identity
  - Agreement on use pattern
  - Agreement on interpretation of test results

### Two Test substance definitions

- Ethanol, absolute
  - Ethanol 99.5%
  - Water 0.5%
- Ethanol, azeotropic
  - Ethanol 95.6%
  - Water 4.4%

### A formulated product

- British completely denatured alcohol
  - Ethanol 90%
  - Methanol 9.5%
  - Pyridine 0.5%
  - Naphtha 0.375%
  - Methylviolet 1.5 ppm
